HELEN'S STRATHSPEY



A 32 Bar Strathspey for 3 couples

Bars

1 - 4 lst man casts off two places to finish in the centre facing
3rd lady. At the same time lst lady dances across to the
men's side and casts off behind 2nd man to finish in the
centre facing 2nd lady

2nd couple step up slightly on Bars 3 - 4




- 5 10 Reels of three across the dance; lst man with 3rd couple and lst lady with 2nd couple; lst lady finishes between 2nd couple all facing down and lst man between 3rd couple all facing up
- 11 12 Joining hands in 3's across the dance all set
- 13 16 All three couples circle to the left to finish all on the wrong side of the dance. lst man finishing in top place on the ladies side and lst lady in third place on the men's side
- 17 20 lst couple set advancing to each other and turn once round with two hands
- 21 24 lst lady then casts up behind the men's side of the dance to finish in the centre at the top facing down. At the same time lst man casts off behind the ladies side to finish in third place in the centre of the dance facing up

Meanwhile:

2nd and 3rd couples set to their partners and turn with two hands, so that 3rd couple face 1st lady and 2nd couple face 1st man

2nd and 3rd couples are still on the wrong sides



- 25 26 3rd and 2nd couples make an arch and dance to 1st and 3rd places respectively while 1st couple dance under the arches to the centre passing left shoulder so all are on the wrong sides
- 27 28 All three couples turn partners with two hands, once round
- 29 32 The ladies following 3rd lady and the men following 2nd man chase home to their own side of the dance

lst couple are now in second place on own side ready to start again

Repeat having passed a couple
